Professor doctor Mahmoud Hesabi was born in 1903 in Tehran. His parents were from Tafresh. After 4 years in Tehran he left for Beirut. He started school at the age of 7, while the family was in a poor economical condition and with the hardship of being far from his native land. At the same time, he was taught religious lessons and Persian literature by his mother. Professor learned the Holy Quran by heart with deep belief and get familiar with the poems of Hafez, Boostan and Golestan, Shahname of Ferdowsi, and so on. Then he continued his studies and researches in physics at Sorbonne University in Paris and got his PhD in physics with a perfect degree at the age of 25.

He was the first and only Iranian student of professor Albert Einstein.

Professor Hesabi was chosen as the world's Man of the year in physics in 1989. On the 3rd of September 1992 at 7:30 when he was still a university professor at Tehran University, he passed away in hospital of Geneva University after a period of illness.
